

HOW TO INSTALL YOUR DECKING

Please read these instructions carefully and familiarise yourself with the process before you start.

We recommend you install your decking in a temperature between 16-27 degrees Celsius.

The tools you will need include:

Acetone Cleaning Rags (that are free from contaminates and dyes) Masking Tape/Painters Tape

- 1. Place the SurfDek pieces on a flat surface, this allows them to flatten out.
- 2. Thoroughly **clean the surface** of your deck using soapy water and brush. After washing, **dry the surface** completely.
- 3. Using acetone, **wipe the surface** to remove any stubborn grease, oil, residue etc.
- 4. Do not attempt to install your SurfDek flooring until the area is 100% dry.
- 5. Without removing the 3M backing, **lay out all of the pieces** in their designated places to ensure they fit properly.
- 6. Once you are happy to start the installation, turn each individual panel over and **score only the 3M backing** with a knife. Be careful not to cut through into your SurfDek flooring.
- 7. **Lightly fold against the cut line** to open up the 3M backing for easy peeling.
- 8. Exactly realign the piece in the desired position. **Use the masking or painter's tape to hold down one half** firmly of the piece up to just before the cut line. It is important that the piece does not move.
- 9. Lift and fold up the non-taped side to expose the 3M backing. **Start peeling back the 3M backing** from the cut line, working up over until it is removed.

10.	Slowly start folding the panel back down into its place. We recommend as the adhesive comes in contact with the deck you smooth out the surface firmly , to reduce air trappage. Ensure the edges have a firm grip.
11.	Then, remove the tape from the opposite end of the panel and repeat the process.

This process should be used for each piece of your SurfDek marine flooring.
